A word used in place of a noun

She would like **it** better with sprinkles, whipped cream, and a cherry.

A word that describes or gives more information about a noun or pronoun

The **pudgy** pooch quickly devoured the **greasy** bacon.

## conjunction

A word that connects words or groups of words

I enjoy rock, hip-hop, **and** jazz, **but** not classical music.

## interjection

**interjections**  
Yes!  
Ouch!  
Awesome!  
Cool!  
Yikes!

A word that expresses surprise or strong feeling

**Wow!** That was the best movie I've ever seen.
